Distribution Reports and Bulk Retail Facility Reports Due December 15th

Distribution reports are due December 15. This is a hard deadline and penalties may be incurred for late filing. This is the filing deadline for Bulk Retail Facilities.

Distribution reports are important because they allow us to reconcile your activity with our records and therefore fulfill the requirement for accountability and traceability. It is the final step in closing out the current year in preparation for the New Year. Certification in 2019 cannot proceed until records are finalized for the current year.

The distribution report is located on the back of the Certificate of Inspection. KCIA requires only the amount sold as certified seed, amount used for own use, amount sold as grain and the amount to be carried over for next year. It is not necessary to list every sale, though doing so during the selling season will assist you in completing the distribution report.

Be sure to include the office copies of bulk sales certificates.

If there is any sales activity after you have submitted your reports, simply call KCIA to update your records. Please do not postpone submitting your distribution reports on the chance there may be sales activity after submittal.

This is a period of heavy record activity for KCIA, so your efforts to submit complete and accurate distribution reports are greatly appreciated.
